In addition, the incumbent will be responsible for preparing a variety of reports and correspondence including amendments to the City of Vancouver Electrical By-law

The position requires university graduation in Electrical Engineering and registration or eligible for registration as a Prefessional Engineer in B.C. The successful candidate will have considerable experience in all phases of the electrical industry, preferably with inspectional and regulatory responsibilities or design and field review experience. Their experience will include supervisory and administrative responsibility. A thorough knowledge of the Canadian Electrical Code is a necessity. Candidates must have excellent organizational and interpersonal skills, well developed oral and written communication skills and a demonstrated ability in dealing effectively with the public and staff.
